

HB 97: Juvenile Hearings - Continuances
2008 Budget Session
Sponsor: Rep. Tom Lubnau (R-H31, Gillette)

HB 97 would have allowed juvenile court hearings to be deferred upon the motion of the court or of any other party, with no time limit for resumption of action.

Supporters thought the bill might make the juvenile court system more efficient.

Opponents characterized the bill as a limitation of due process rights of juveniles and unconstitutional, and believed it would provide nothing positive to anyone.

The House passed HB 97, 47-12 (1 excused), but the Senate killed the bill on its first floor vote, 10-19 (1 excused).

The votes listed below are the House third reading (final passage) and Senate Committee of the Whole (first reading) votes. A YES vote means the legislator wanted to allow juvenile court hearings to be deferred upon motion, while a NO vote means the legislator did not want to allow juvenile court hearings to be deferred in this manner.
